Please list the steps you have taken to assure yourself you have not acquired citizenship of another country by descent, marriage or other means.

My father arrived in Australia shortly after his eleventh birthday in July 1939 as a stateless person. His parents (my paternal grandparents) arrived in Australia also as stateless persons in December 1939. All had been stripped of their German citizenship by the Nazi regime on racial grounds.

My father and his parents were naturalised in 1946 under the Nationality Act 1920-1936, and then became Australian citizens under the Australian Citizenship Act 1948.

Under a 1952 German law, former German citizens stripped of citizenship by the Nazi regime on racial grounds, and their descendants, have a right to apply for German citizenship if they elect to do so and undertake the requisite application process. Citizenship is not automatically conferred under this law.

Neither I, nor my father, nor my paternal grandparents have ever applied for German citizenship.

I am, and always have been, a sole Australian citizen.

My wife became an Australian citizen in November 1980, and by force of then current Chilean law automatically renounced her Chilean citizenship, becoming a sole Australian citizen.

My wife and I were married on 6 March 1983. She was then, and remains, a sole Australian citizen.
